



Position Title: Senior Archaeologist Technician

Position Summary:

The Senior Archaeologist will provide support to the Archeological Resource Program. Based on data sets, information, maps, and materials provided by the government the Senior Archaeologist will perform routine archeological field surveys, recordation, monitoring, and testing and/or lab work.

Job Duties:

- Conduct archaeological survey and National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) evaluation of archaeological sites. Complete all necessary state site forms, FB forms, state activity forms, maps, and prepare a quality technical report for the program managers.
- Provide all necessary electronic data including photographs, GPS files and GIS shapefiles.
- Conduct Archaeological testing and archaeological monitoring of undertakings as assigned by program managers. Prepare summary of results and fill out appropriate monitoring forms.
- Perform lab work such as artifact analysis, soil flotation, archival research and basic curatorial tasks.
- Perform NEPA analysis.

The ideal candidate must be a self-starter who can manage multiple assignments simultaneously and shift priorities as necessary in order to meet deadlines. He/she must also be able to work independently or with others, and communicate in a professional and timely manner. The candidate must meet the below required knowledge, skills, and abilities.

Minimum Requirements

Candidate must have a Bachelors degree in Archaeology, Anthropology, or related discipline and a minimum of 2 years experience, preferably in the Southwest United State. Candidate must have experience with field or laboratory work. Candidate must be proficient with ArcGIS 9.x.
